MORE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Summer Riding camps, May will see the launch of our Rookie Riders pilot program, for ages 4-7. April will see the start of ground work lessons, competition leases and coaching, birthday parties, cart driving lessons, horse training in starting horses, conditioning and fine tuning, further educating horses in their training, Liberty training, harness/driving training, problem 'horses' (we specialize in rescues and trauma cases) and boarding for your horse.

BEGINNER LESSON PROGRAM

We currently have three spots remaining open in our Introduction to Horses for Beginners program, which will launch mid April for six weeks. Absolutely no experience necessary. This program runs three times a year!

This program runs two times a week, for six weeks, with one lesson on the ground learning all about safety and stable management topics, and the other is an introduction to riding. Once beginners go through this program, they can move forward with Private lessons once a week, until they are ready in ability to join our regular program, providing there is space.

REGULAR LESSON PROGRAM



(To sign up for this one, experience is a must) Our regular lesson program is a commitment that consists of 10 lessons per month, 8 riding and 2 ground work. You have the option to choose between group or private sessions. All lessons are set at the start of each month and will run at the same time every week. If weather is not cooperative for riding, we substitute with stable management seminars, as we do not offer cancellations.

CASUAL RIDING SPOTS

Depending on how full our schedule gets, we can offer some casual private/group lessons throughout the month for those that can not commit to our lesson programs. These however are not guaranteed, as it depends on if there are spaces available. Those in our regular lesson program have seniority of the schedule, so unfortunately if the program fills, we may not have availability for casual riders every month.

ADULT LESSON PROGRAM

Our adult program is designed for our busy lives with two lessons a week to give you your horsey fix. One riding lesson and one ground work lesson, all at a set time every week, so you can add it into your busy adulting schedule. Visit our website for further details.
